The Lord's Call Came Unexpectedly

It Came to Unexpected Individuals

- **Self Doubting Individuals**

**(Exodus 3:10-11, 4:13, Judges 6:12-15,
Jeremiah 1:6)**

- **Imperfect Individuals**

(Exodus 4:14, Luke 6:12-16, Acts 9:1-6)



The Lord's Call Came Unexpectedly

We Too Are Unexpected Individuals

- **We Too Doubt Ourselves and Are Imperfect**

- **But The Lord Still Calls**

(Exodus 4:14-17, Acts 9:11-16)



The Lord's Call Came With Reassurance

The Lord Reassured Them:

- **They Are His Creation**
(Exodus 4:11, Jeremiah 1:4-5)
- **He Gave Them What to Speak**
(Exodus 4:12, Jeremiah 1:9)
- **He Was With Them, There Was No Need to Fear**
(Joshua 1:1-9, Jeremiah 1:8, Ezekiel 3:8-9)



The Lord's Call Came With Reassurance

The Lord Reassures Us:

- We Are His Creation**

(Genesis 1:26-28, Isaiah 40:29, Philippians 4:13)

- He Gives Us What to Speak**

(Acts 8:26-40, 2 Timothy 3:16-17)

- He Is With Us, There Is No Need to Fear**

(Hebrews 13:5-6, Acts 4:29, Ephesians 6:19)

We Need to be Ready for It

(Acts 17:16-34, 2 Timothy 4:2)

We Must Not Reject It

(Jonah 1-2, James 4:17)



Answering The Lord's Call Today

We Will Meet Opposition

(2 Timothy 4:2-5, Ezekiel 2:1-8)
