Jesus Is Advocate First, Judge Second (Rom. 5:8; Mark 16:19; Heb. 7:25; 4:15, 16; 1 John 2:1, 2; Heb. 9:27; 2 Cor. 5:9, 10).

Jesus Is the Light of the World (v. 12; Isa. 9:2; John 9:5; Eph. 5:8-11; 1 John 1:6, 7; Ezek. 33:11; Matt. 9:12, 13).
