### Son of God, King of Israel

o "The expression 'the son of <u>fill-in-the-blank</u>' can have an extraordinarily wide range of meanings, owing in part to the influence of Hebrew on the Greek of the New Testament. Hebrew does not have as many adjectives as do some languages, and compensates for the lack by a variety of idiomatic structures, including this one. Thus a 'wicked man' might be called 'a son of wickedness' (Psalms 89:22); people in trouble are 'sons of affliction' (Proverbs 31:5); valorous men are 'sons of valor' (Dt. 3:18). Those deserving execution are 'sons of death' (I Samuel 26:16). Small wonder, then, that Judas Iscariot can be called (literally) a 'son of perdition'. In the sermon on the mount, peacemakers are called 'sons of God' (Mt. 5:9), because their peacemaking attests that in this respect at least they are imitating God. Like father, like son: so it was in the ancient world, far more strongly than today." (Pillar New Testament Commentary, 161)



### oJesus is the Ladder

- o Genesis 28:10-22
- o Genesis 28:12- "And he dreamed, and behold, there was a ladder set up on the earth, and the top of it reached heaven. And behold, the angels of God were ascending and descending on it!"

### oJesus is the Ladder

- o <u>John 10:9-</u> "I am the gate (door). If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will come in and go out and find pasture."
- o<u>John 4:21-</u> "Jesus said to her, 'Woman, believe me, the hour is coming when neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem will you worship the Father." Vs. 23- "But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship Him."

### oJesus is the Ladder

o<u>Malachi 1:9-11</u>- "And now entreat the favor of God, that He may be gracious to us. With such a gift from your hand, will He show favor to any of you? Says the Lord of hosts. Oh that there were one among you who would shut the doors, that you might not kindle fire on my altar in vain! I have no pleasure in you, says the Lord of hosts, and I will not accept an offering from your hand. For from the rising of the sun to its setting my name will be great among the nations (Gentiles), and in every place incense will be offered to my name, and a pure offering. For my name will be great among the nations, says the Lord of hosts."

### oJesus is the Ladder

o<u>2 Corinthians 1:20-</u> "For all the promises of God find their 'Yes' in Him" (speaking of the Son of God, Jesus Christ in vs. 19). "That is why it is through Him that we utter our Amen to God for His glory"
