### What Is Truth? OBasic Tenets of Postmodernism

- Autonomous Individualism:
  - O No Absolute Truth
- O Absolute Moral Relativism:
  - O Postmodernism... "makes an idol of witless, inexpensive moral toleration. It views all moral values as arbitrarily contingent upon the changing social and psychological determinants of human cultures."
  - Inability of knowing an absolute standard of good and evil.
